In Today's Episode...

The Clu Crew investigates a house that appears to be haunted. As they do so, they learn about the *right* kind of fear vs. the wrong kind of fear and that things aren't always as they seem.



Follow the Clues...

Alongside every exciting mystery, the Clu Crew grow in their faith by discovering the truths inside Scripture. Did you spot the Bible verses they used to solve personal puzzles?

- Peter explains that ghosts are not real because the Bible teaches that those who pass away don't come back to earth. (Hebrews 9:27)
- Bonnie reminds the kids of who we are to fear, "I tell you, my friends, do not fear those who kill the body, and after that have nothing more that they can do. But I will warn you whom to fear: fear him who, after he has killed, has authority to cast into hell. Yes, I tell you, fear him!" (Luke 12:4-5)



Solve the Mystery...

Today's adventure was full of lessons that teach us how to come closer to Jesus and live by His Word. Here are 3 discussion topics that will help connect the story to your daily life:

1. What does it mean to fear God? Is it right to have the "fear of the Lord?" (Proverbs 9:10) Why or why not?
2. The Clu children believed the house was haunted until they learned that the Bible says people who have died don't come back as ghosts. What does this teach us about knowing our Bible?
3. At the start of the episode, the Clu children were scared of the house. Is there something that you are afraid of? How did the Clu Crew work through their fear and what can you learn from their example?
