- At the end, we have to decide, are we wise or foolish? The Bible says, "The tongue of the wise uses knowledge rightly, But the mouth of fools pours forth foolishness." (Proverbs 15:2)



### Solve the Mystery...

Today's adventure was full of lessons that teach us how to come closer to Jesus and live by His Word. Here are 3 discussion topics that will help connect the story to your daily life:

1. Abby's friend Sarah betrayed her. Have you ever had a friend betray you or someone be mean to you? What can you learn from Abby's example of how to handle it?
2. Can you describe what gossip is? Why it is a bad thing? Can you think of a time you gossiped about someone and need to ask for their forgiveness?
3. The children's teacher, Miss Murphy, says she hopes they will learn to treat their words like gold. What do you think this means, to treat your words like gold?
